



DESK HOURS & SERVICES



Your community office is your go-to when looking for resources. You can always go to your community office whenever you need help or have questions. In the office, you'll find your community coordinator, or their office staff, who can help you with:

- Lockouts from your room
- Questions about moving in or out
- Help with submitting a work order
- Checking out cleaning supplies for your room



Your UCF ID is your room key - always keep it safe and with you!

Community access is restricted to those who live in the building. Do not hold doors open for other students - though the Knight Way is to always be a good neighbor, each resident is responsible for their own access to the building to keep us all as safe as possible.

You will also receive a key to your mailbox that must be returned at the end of the year!

MAIL & DELIVERIES

You will receive an email when your packages are ready for pick up. Please do not come to the mail center prior to receiving that email!

Each community is assigned a mail center. Residents of that community will not be able to pick up their packages at any other mail center.

Grocery deliveries such as Hello Fresh are accepted by our mail centers when delivered through a traditional package carrier (USPS, FedEx, UPS, DHL, etc.)

Food deliveries like Uber Eats or Door Dash are **NOT** accepted at our mail centers or community office front desks. Students **MUST** meet the delivery driver outside of the residence hall to receive their order, such as the nearest parking lot.



ON-CAMPUS WIFI & INTERNET

Wifi is available to all students in all residence halls. Log into the wifi using your UCF NID (ex. Kn123456) and your password.

To connect to internet using a standard ethernet cable:

- 1. Securely plug one end of the ethernet cable into the ethernet port on your device and the other end into the orange data jack on the wall.
- 2. Open your web browser and enter the ResNet website.
- 3. Once on the website, click on the Registration link and follow the steps to register for ResNet service.
- 4. If you experience any problems with your ResNet registration or service, you may submit a work ticket on the UCFIT website, or you may contact the Service Desk at 407.823.5117, Monday through Friday 8 AM to 5 PM or by email at itsupport@ucf.edu.

MAINTENANCE 101

Top 5 maintenance tips

1.

Leave thermostat in AUTO. Placing the system to ON will create air quality issues.

2.

Bring cleaning supplies to maintain a healthy space. Clean the toilet, shower & sink weekly for best results

5.

For maintenance best practices, refer to the Community Living Guide section "Your Room, Your Rights, Your Facilities." Make sure you submit a work order for all issues. Do not rely on roommates or RA.

4.

If you experience a water event, flooding, leaks, etc. quickly pick up your belongings and put them on a higher surface such as your bed.

WHO TO CALLAND WHEN

RA on Call/Community Office

Call the RA on Call/Community Office when you're locked out, have time sensitive questions or concerns, or if there is an urgent issue. This number is answered 24 hours a day, 7 days a week if you need anything. You can find this number on the first page of this guide. If you have an emergency, call 911.

Your RA

Your RAs are here to help you when they can, but remember, they are also UCF Students. If you have general questions that are not time sensitive, feel free to ask your RA. You should always call the Community Office number if there is an elevated issue, or if it's late at night.

Work Control

You can submit work request online, but if there is a more urgent maintenance concern, you should call the number below. Examples include when there is a severe leak in your room, if your electricity goes out, or if an elevator isn't working properly.


