## Bedding Essentials

(Apollo, Libra, Nike, Hercules, Neptune, Lake Claire, Rosen: X-Long twin (80"))  
(Towers: Full-Size, NorthView: Full-Size XL),

- ☐ Comforter or duvet
- ☐ Sheets
- ☐ Pillowcases & pillows
- ☐ Throw blanket
- ☐ Mattress topper
- ☐ Mattress pad

## Kitchen & Cooking:

- ☐ Microwave  
(no more than 1000 watts)
- ☐ Mini fridge  
(no more than 5 cubic feet)
- ☐ Eating utensils
- ☐ Dishes
- ☐ Pots & pans
- ☐ Water Pitcher
- ☐ Ice cube trays
- ☐ Food containers
- ☐ Single serving coffee maker
- ☐ Only permitted in apartment and community kitchens: *Toasters, rice cookers, crock pots, & air fryers*

## Emergency/Hurricane Items

- ☐ First aid kit/ medicine
- ☐ Flashlight
- ☐ Batteries
- ☐ Non-perishable food
- ☐ Water
- ☐ Power bank

## What NOT to bring:

- Animals (other than fish in a 10 gallon or smaller tank)
- Fireworks, Hot Plates, Incense, Candles (No Open Flames)
- Curtains used in hallways, windows, or as partitions
- Firearms, explosives, or any sharp weaponry
- Halogen Lamps & scented plug ins
- Illegal substances, tobacco/vapors and drug paraphernalia

## Bedroom Essentials

- ☐ Desk Lamp
- ☐ Underbed Storage
- ☐ Hangers
- ☐ Laundry hamper
- ☐ Shoe Storage
- ☐ Desk organizer
- ☐ Full length mirror
- ☐ Wall prints & decorations
- ☐ Command strips & thumb tacks
- ☐ Power strip 120-volt U.L. *Approved/ built-in manual reset 15 and circuit breaker/ maximum length cord six (6) feet/maximum six (6) outlets at end of cord*

## Bathroom:

- ☐ Toiletries
- ☐ Towels & washcloths
- ☐ Wastebasket with plastic liners
- ☐ Toilet paper
- ☐ Bathmat
- ☐ Hand soap
- ☐ Plunger
- ☐ Decorative shower curtains (optional)
- ☐ Standing shower caddy or tote bag

## Cleaning:

- ☐ All-purpose spray
- ☐ Disinfecting wipes
- ☐ Toilet bowl cleaner
- ☐ Toilet brush
- ☐ Shower/bathroom cleaner (with bleach)
- ☐ Sponges/scrub brush
- ☐ Dish soap
- ☐ Vacuum or broom
- ☐ Swiffer mop with wet and dry pads
- ☐ Laundry detergent
