BEFORE YOU ARRIVE CHECKLIST

- Pick up your **UCF ID** during orientation and have it ready at check-in. This is your room key and you will not be able to access your room without it.
- Schedule a Move-In Appointment through the Housing Portal
- Download Move-In pass through the Housing Portal
- Purchase Resident parking permit online at: parking.ucf.edu
- Review the Community Living Guide (CLG)

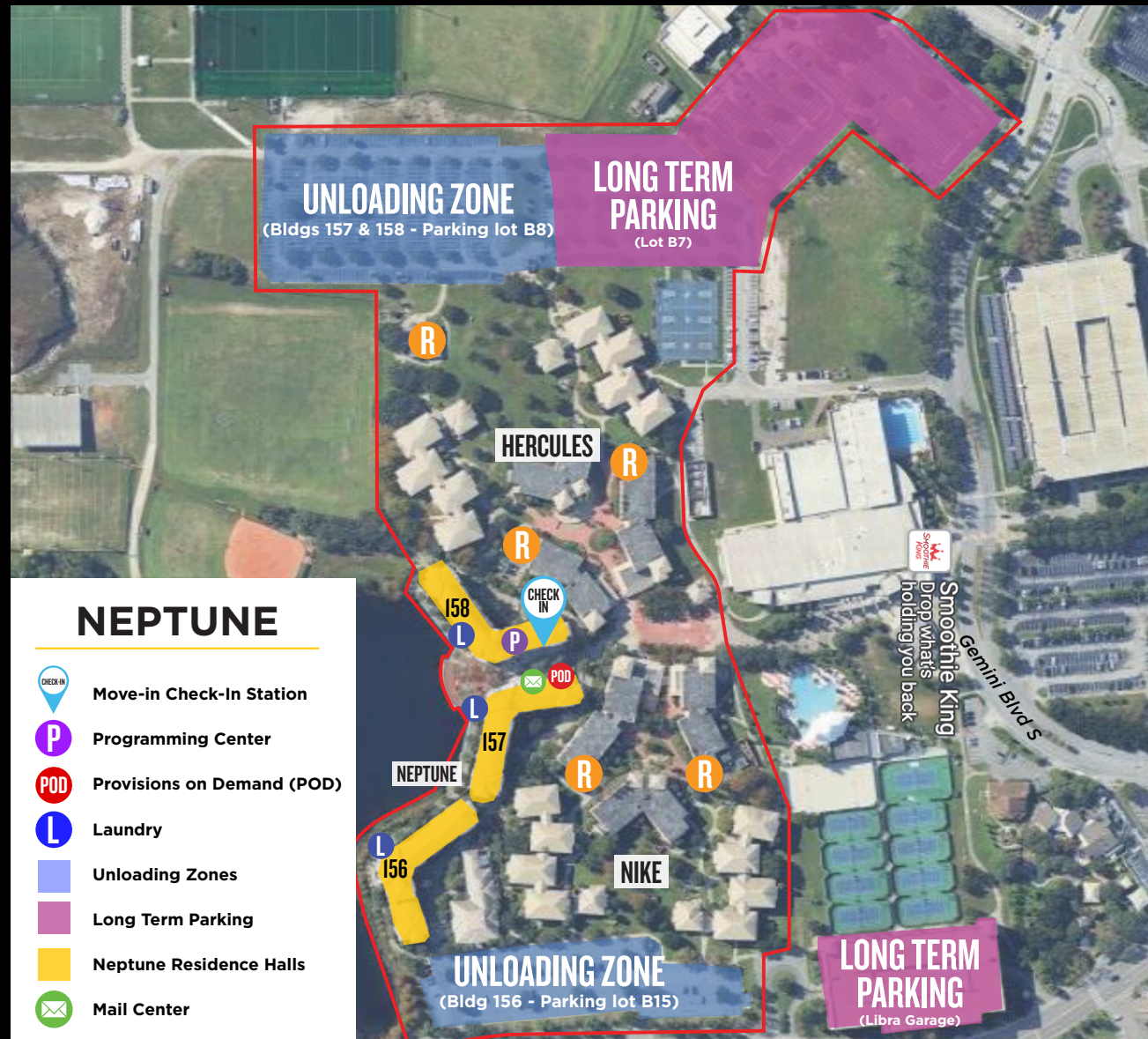
Parking is free in unloading zones and long-term parking areas during move-in.

MOVE-IN DAY TIMELINE

Fall Move-In: Thursday, August 20th - Saturday, August 22nd

- Arrive during your appointment time
- Head to your community's unloading zone
- Families and Guests: begin unloading your student's belongings
- (While guests unload) Student should: Go to the community office to check-in
- (optional) Check-out available equipment
- Return to vehicle and continue unloading
- Move your vehicle to long term parking

BEDROOM

- **Full-size bed:** Towers
- **Full-size XL bed:** NorthView
- Comforter & blankets
- Sheets
- Pillowcases & pillows
- Mattress topper
- Desk lamp
- Storage & hangers
- Laundry hamper
- Shoe storage
- Mirror
- Wall prints & decorations
- Command strips & thumbtacks
- Powerstrip

BATHROOM

- Toiletries
- Towels & washcloths
- Trashcan & trash bags
- Toilet paper
- Bathmat
- Decorative shower curtains (optional)
- **STANDING** shower caddy or tote bag (NO hanging caddies are permitted)

EMERGENCY & HURRICANE ITEMS

- First aid kit/ medicine
- Flashlight
- Batteries
- Water
- Power bank



CLEANING

- Shower/bathroom cleaner (with bleach)
- Disinfecting wipes
- Toilet brush & cleaner
- Sponges/ scrub brush
- Dish soap
- Vacuum or broom
- Swiffer mop with wet & dry pads
- Laundry detergent

KITCHEN & COOKING

- Microwave (under 1000 watts)
- Mini-fridge (under 5 cubic ft)
- Utensils
- Dishes
- Pots & pans
- Water filter
- Coffee maker
- Apartment & community kitchens only: Toasters, rice cookers, crock pots, and air fryers.

DO NOT BRING

- **NO Hanging shower caddies**
- Animals (other than fish in a 10 gallon or smaller tank)
- Bed lofts or risers
- Halogen Lamps & scented plug-ins
- Curtains used in hallways, windows, or as partitions
- Firearms, explosives, or any sharp weaponry
- Illegal substances, tobacco/vapors, and drug paraphernalia
- Devices using an open flame

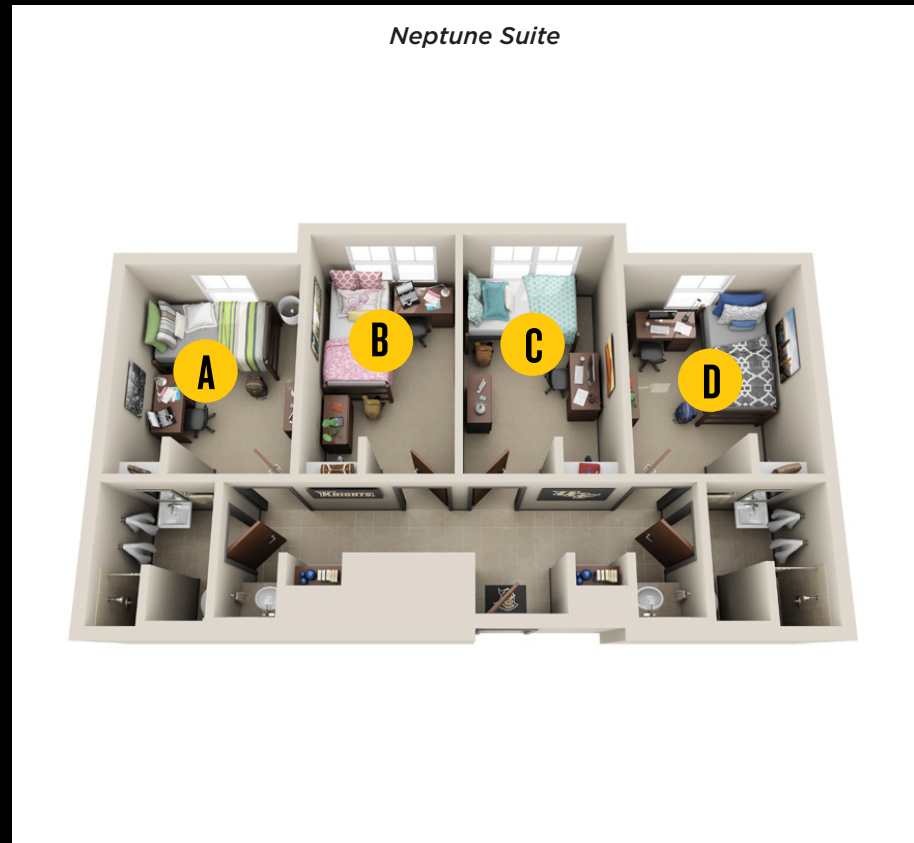

MOVE-IN TIPS



Arrive in your 15-minute appointment window!

Note: You do **NOT** have to move-in within that window, you will have all day!
